1. Introduction

- 1.1 This Cookie Policy explains how Ergonn, LLC ("Ergonn," "we," "us," or "our") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies when you visit and interact with our website at ergonn.com (the "Platform").
- 1.2 By accessing or using the Platform, you consent to the use of cookies and similar technologies as described in this policy.
 - 2. What are Cookies?
- 2.1 Cookies are small text files that are placed on your device (e.g., computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you visit a website. They are widely used to make websites work more efficiently and provide a better browsing experience.
- 2.2 Cookies may be session cookies (temporary cookies that are erased when you close your browser) or persistent cookies (cookies that remain on your device until they expire or are manually deleted).
 - 3. How We Use Cookies
- 3.1 We use cookies and similar tracking technologies for various purposes, including:
- a. Essential Cookies: These cookies are necessary for the functioning of the Platform and enable you to navigate and use its features. They are usually set in response to your actions, such as accessing secure areas or filling out forms on the Platform.



b. Performance and Analytics Cookies: These cookies help us analyze how users interact with the Platform, gather information about website traffic, and improve our services. They may collect anonymous, aggregated data that does not personally identify you.

c. Functional Cookies: These cookies allow the Platform to remember choices you have made and provide enhanced functionality and personalization. For example, they may remember your username, language preferences, or region.

d. Advertising and Targeting Cookies: These cookies are used to deliver advertisements that are relevant to your interests. They may also be used to limit the number of times you see an advertisement and measure the effectiveness of advertising campaigns.

4. Third-Party Cookies

4.1 We may allow third-party service providers to place cookies on the Platform for the purposes described in Section 3. These providers may include analytics providers, advertising networks, and social media platforms.

4.2 Third-party cookies are subject to the respective privacy policies of these providers. We do not have control over or access to cookies placed by third parties, and their use is governed by the privacy policies of those third parties.

5. Cookie Management

5.1 By default, most web browsers are set to accept cookies. However, you can control and manage cookies in your browser settings. You can choose to block or delete cookies, limit their use to specific websites, or set your browser to prompt you before accepting a cookie.
